


Brief Bio on our guest speaker

Br. Bill Short, OFM, is a friar of the St. Barbara Province of the Franciscan Friars. Born in Seattle Washington, Br. Bill was raised in a Franciscan parish there. After graduating from the University of San Francisco, he entered the Franciscan Friars in 1972. He studied at the Franciscan School of Theology iat the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley (MA, 1976), and at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, where he received the degree of Doctor of Sacred Theology (1983).

Since 1983 he has been teaching at the Franciscan School, first in Berkeley and now in Oceanside CA. His teaching is in the area of Christian Spirituality, with a special emphasis on Franciscan Spirituality. He also serves as a translator for international Franciscan meetings, and has served as Visitor General for the Franciscan Friars of the Province of Jalisco in Mexico and the Province of South Africa. Currently he is Director of the International Franciscan Study and Research Center (*Collegium Sancti Bonaventurae*) in Rome. He is also a collector of California native plants and an amateur wine-maker.

You must be sincerely dedicated to that "high standard of ordinary Christian living" (ibid.), to which I invited all the faithful at the end of the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000.
